November 12, 2025

Call to Order: Commissioner Chairman Engels called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Commissioner Chairman Engels led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Reading and Disposal of Budget Hearing and Regular Meeting Minutes from October 21, 2025: Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to accept the meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Chief Darcangelis reports that they had one member resign, has to go through the volunteers as well first (Ed Sawester).

Chief Darcangelis reports that he will need 3 pagers, cost is approximately \$358 for each pager. Motion moved by Commissioner Engels to order 3 pagers, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Foreman's Report: Bob Darcangelis reports that E-6 will need to have new tires, it still has the original tires on it. He will get a quote and report back.

Other/Old Business: Jeff Rios reports that both gas meters were out for repair, they called NYSEG and a guy from NYSEG was able to fix them.

Jeff Rios also reports that batteries are needed for the CO Meters, they need 7 in total. They have 5 pack for \$56 and a 2 pack for \$25.

Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to purchase batteries and spend up to \$100, seconded by Commissioner Wadhams.

Joe DeSain reminds the Board that the annual Turkey Raffle is this Friday. Joe states that usually the volunteers pay for the items themselves, however this year they received some monetary donations, and he will let Josh DeSain speak on the details.

Josh DeSain reports that he was able to collect \$600 in donations for the Turkey Raffle, 4 donations from businesses (Dobbins Drugs, MVP Auto, LNB and Tallmadge Tire) along with one personal donation from Sean and Imelda Dobbins.
