April 8, 2026

Call to Order: Commissioner Chairman Engels called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Commissioner Chairman Engels led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Reading and Disposal of Regular Meeting Minutes from March 11, 2026: Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to accept and approve the meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Commissioner Engels notes that Northern Star has just requested that the physicals be completed in March for weather purposes.

The Board has discussed payment for the set up and design of our website by Brandon DeSain. Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to pay Brandon DeSain \$500 for his website development, seconded by Commissioner Wadhams.
