Regular Meeting
July 8, 2026

Call to Order: Commissioner Chairman Engels called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Commissioner Chairman Engels led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Reading and Disposal of Regular Meeting Minutes from June 10, 2026: Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to accept and approve the meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Approval of Bills: Prior to the meeting the Treasurer presented the claims against the Fire District in the form of vouchers with attachments. The Board of Fire Commissioners, having reviewed and audited all such claims, on motion of Commissioner Barnes, seconded by Commissioner Figueroa, it was resolved as follows:

RESOLVED, that the Treasurer is hereby ordered to pay the claims against the Fire District as audited and allowed by the Board of Fire Commissioners as set forth in the attached itemization of claims, in the total amount of \$14,087.20.

Purchase of New Uniform Pants: Two drivers need uniform pants.

Motion moved by Commissioner Quinn to purchase 3 pairs of uniform pants at \$65 per pair, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Chief's Report: Chief Darcangelis advises that Peppermint Days parade is Saturday, July 18th, inspection will be at 5pm that night, and the parade starts at 6pm. Fireworks will be that night, and Newark and Clyde FD's will be on standby, and Savannah FD will be at the launch site.

Chief Darcangelis states that they will need to purchase more pagers with the influx of new members joining. He currently has 1 left from the last purchase.

Motion moved by Commissioner Barnes to purchase 2 more pagers, not to exceed \$800, this is to come out of line 10 in the budget, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.

Foreman's Report: Bob Darcangelis stated that the refrigerator stopped working, this is used primarily by the drivers to store their food. Bob checked on pricing at Lowes's. Prices range from \$1700-\$2000.

Motion moved by Commissioner Engels to purchase a new fridge, not to exceed \$2000, seconded by Commissioner Quinn.
